Fishing. Not a golfer? We have reserved a 12 person boat with TIKI Charters in Astoria for salmon fishing and crabbing. A fishing and shellfish license will be required.

Family Fun. A great family friendly trip is to go to Fort Clatsop, Fort Stevens, or Astoria Maritime Museum. Fort Clatsop was the encampment of the Lewis and Clark Expedition during the winter of 1805-1806. Fort Stevens was a WW II fort that protected the mouth of the Columbia River. All are great places to explore!
